subscribe to the Tujibebe Wakenya Party of Kenya (JIBEBE) Code of Conduct and solemnly
declare that: -

1. I pledge my loyalty to the Tujibebe Wakenya Party of Kenya.
2. I shall observe this code of conduct pursuant to Articles 91 and 92 of the Constitution of the Republic of Kenya, Section 8 of the Political Parties Act, the Party's Constitution, and the Party Election and Nomination Rules.
3. I will at all times abide with this code of conduct.
4. I will promote good governance, preserve and protect the respectable image of the party.
5. I will respect the peoples' right to participate in the political associations, including the youth, minorities and marginalized groups.
6. I will respect the democratic rights of other members in competition for political office.
7. I will promote policies responding to the interests, concerns and the needs of the party members.
8. I will respect and promote gender equity and equality, human rights and fundamental freedoms.
9. I will be tolerant and inclusive in all my political activities.
10. I will respect, uphold and promote human dignity, social justice, non-discrimination and protection of the marginalized groups.
11. I will respect, uphold, protect and defend the spirit of the Constitution of the Republic of Kenya.
12. I will respect and uphold other written laws relating to elections and political parties.
13. I will respect, uphold, protect and defend the party constitutions, party election and

nomination rules, manifesto and any other party rules and regulations developed and agreed upon.

14. I will respect, uphold and promote the rule of law.
15. I will promote national patriotism and national unity.
16. I will respect, uphold and promote good governance, integrity, respect, tolerance, transparency and accountability;
17. I will respect all party organs and the Party leadership.
18. I will uphold and promote the principle of free, fair and credible elections within the party organs.
19. I will respect, uphold and promote the principles of leadership and integrity as enshrined in the Constitution of the Republic of Kenya.
20. I will always use practical dialogue to manage and mitigate political differences.
21. I aver that I shall not;
 - i. Engage in or encourage violence among members or supporters.
 - ii. Accept or use public resources for other purposes other than for the allocated use.
 - iii. Engage or promote bribery or any other form of corruption.
 - iv. Engage in or encourage any kind of intimidation of opponents or any other person or political party.
 - v. Advocate for tribalism or any form of discrimination or incitement to cause harm.
 - vi. Allow carrying of weapons or any harmful materials to political meetings.
 - vii. Establish or maintain a Para-military force, militia or similar organization or have any links with such organizations.
 - viii. Obstruct, disrupt, break-up or in any other way whatsoever interfere with a meeting, rally or demonstration of another political party or its leadership
 - ix. Publish or report any false, defamatory or inflammatory allegations about political opponents.

- x. Prevent eligible voters from having access to political opponents.
- xi. Bribe eligible voters.
- xii. Will take all reasonable steps to protect election officers in their course of duty.
- xiii. Will take necessary and reasonable steps to instill discipline in Party candidate representatives, employers, supporters.

22. I shall undertake to;

- i. Adhere to the party programmes and policies for the entire duration that I shall be a member of the party.
- ii. Promote mutual respect to members at all levels.
- iii. Respect party organs and institutions of the party democratization practices.
- iv. Promote the practice of intellectual honesty in all dealings.
- v. Ensure equal distribution of resources.

23. Any member who defaults on the above code of conduct shall be subject to: -

- a. Suspension from the Party.
- b. Denial of elective leadership.
- c. Denial of ticket for candidature.
